"They're called Magic Door Pillows and are created with a magic spell, nothing less. They attract the greatest dreams and thoughts of happiness.




"The spell must be written on the inside of the door, to hold the best dreams this land has in store.

"I have a spell to use that will shrink me to the size of a mouse. Your fairy dust I'll need and a generous douse."


PUFF! And just like that, The Sleepy Wizard was as small as a mouse.

With a wave of his wand and the spell that he said, a Magic Door Pillow appeared on each of their beds.


"Dream Fairy, you sleep inside the pink pillow, I'll take the blue. But we must be quick. I can hear the children coming, can you?"

But, where could they have come from? They were not here before. You couldn't help but feel the magic coming from inside these little doors.







That night, the children both slept as soundly as can be. Neither woke at all. From their nightmares, they were free.

How to continue the magic

The magic is in the letters: the sending and receiving between your children and their magic friends. Each night before bed, as a part of your children's bedtime routines, they can write or draw a picture of what they would like to dream about, and mail it in the pillow's magic mailbox. Your children can read the spell on the inside of the pillow's door, then tuck their wizard or fairy into the pillow to go to sleep at the same time as they do.
